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# Chapter 1

# **Specification Introduction**

The Jarltech 8031 programmable keyboards have been specially designed for use with personal computers or terminals in point-of-sale and industrial applications. This manual describes how to connect the Jarltech keyboard to your system, how to design a keyboard layout which meets your special requirements, and how to install your keyboard layout into the Jarltech keyboard. There are two model of 8031.

One is a tactile keyboard with seven rows and fifteen columns for a maximum of 105 keys; another emulates for QWERTY keyboard layout. Both of them are with single, double, and quadruple key caps. For the keyboard layout, key function sand key data strings are completely programmable.

Each keyboard is capable of two concurrent keyboard maps with switching between the maps controlled by one designated key. Go to Appendix I for picture reviewing.

JP-8031 is set simulation the windows standard keyboard, connected to the usb port without driver. AUX KB port can connect standard PS/2 keyboard, and AUX RS232 port can connect any external RS232 devices (e.g., bar code scanner) and transmitting that data to a host computer via either the keyboard wedge or an RS232








# 4-4 Keyboard Key Map Setting

# 4-4-2 Common Setting

#### **Click Sound:**

This setting allows user enable click sound of keys.

#### **Key Repeat:**


This setting allows user enable keys repeating speed.

The 8031 has two maps for designs. This keyboard allows use defining a key to switch maps; once a key be enabled for map changing function, then, the keyboard map will be changed from map1 to map2 when press this key.

#### Delay time for each char:


When user scrolling the scale, the key string output speed between characters.(0  $\sim$  2.55 Sec.).



# 4-4-3 KeyLock Level Setting

When the optional KeyLock Module be installed, this setting allows user define key lock's level. i.e. when you set key #1 to be level 1 and level 2, then the key#1 can only be used when the keylock be set to level 1 or level 2 by user's key.

Note: Jarltech JP-8031 allow user to set keylock level for 6 levels.

#### Set Default:




### 4-4-5 String Editer

The field allows users to define string for one single key. i.e. when you set key #1 as "Welcome to Jarltech Web Site", then the output will be "
WELCOME TO JARLTECH WEB SITE" after pressed key #1.

Above buttons of the "String Editor" field in the picture are tools for editing key contents. You may use them to edit string or characters.


The "Special key" is as bellow, which is designed for "special function", you may use the "special key " to define each key as picture's below. i.e. In your key #1 setting field, click <F1> from the special key and add it to your "current string property", after you write it to map(you may use "single key program" to write data of a key), press key #1. the <F1> function appears as QWERTY PC keyboard behavior.

You may also set "ALT" and "Shift" functions key On/Off to fit your expect. In keyboard mode, the capital characters cannot be type on the field, and you may click "Shift ON" before the string to set them on, i.e: <shift-on> 1234<shift-off>5678, The result will be: !@#\$5678

### 4-5 MSR Setting

### 4-5-1 Main Setting

#### **Error Beep Sound:**

Enable / disable sound when MSR reading error.

#### **Prefix / Suffix:**

Enable or disable prefix / suffix for MSR data

When the check box on, you can edit the prefix / suffix, every fields in up to 7 characters.

Note: The format of output data is:

#### [MSR Prefix] [Track1 data] [Track2 data] [Track3 data] [MSR Suffix]

#### **Track 2 Shows Credit Card Number Only:**

Enable or disable Track 2 Shows Credit Card Number Only.

#### **Enable Caps lock When Output:**

Enable or disable the Caps Lock fix to on when the MSR data outputting.

#### **MSR Enable:**

Enable or disable MSR Function.



# 4-5-2 MSR right side button function

#### **MSR Write:**

This Button is for write the data settings to 8031 MSR.

#### **Set Default:**


This Button is for set the data to default.

### 4-5-3 Track1~3 Setting

#### LRC sentinel


Enable / Disable the LRC sentinel is the checksum character for the data of card track.

#### Left to Right decode and Right to Left decode

You can make choice to decide the user to swipe card and read data only from left to right or from right to left or both ways

### 4-5-4 MSR ISO Standard Setting

For the ISO standard field settings, you need to set the check box of "Field Splitting Enable" for ON, then the data of card track will be outputted and follow the ISO standard fields.


You can set the "Send CR" or/and "Send LF" for every ISO fields.

# Appendix II Troubleshooting

# 1. Q: Why is there a period of blank time before the "beep" indication of successful programming?

A: The software has to initialize the download data to keyboard during this period, so please wait some seconds.

# 2. Q: Why we can not program this 8031 keyboard through the USB port?

A: 1. Check if your connection of hardware is correct.

2. Check if your setting in 8031 programming tool is correct.

### 3. Q: How to program a guard key correctly?

A: For Programming a quad key, please program one of the four keys with data only and disable the other three keys. The double-key is set by the same method, Or to programming a double key or quad key with same data for every keys.
